COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROGRAM

Albertville City Schools will be participating in the USDA "Community Eligibility Program" (CEP) this school year. CEP allows all students in our school system to eat breakfast and lunch at no charge each day. Meal applications will not be required in order for students to be able to participate. Any purchase of extra meals or 'a la carte' items can be purchased with cash in hand or from the student meal account. Students will continue to use their assigned lunch number at the registers in order to ensure accurate record keeping.

WHAT HAPPENS TO THE MONEY I HAD IN MY STUDENT'S ACCOUNT?

Your child's money rolls over from year to year and school to school. Any remaining funds will be available for use on a la carte or extra items on the first day of school.

HOW CAN I ACCESS INFORMATION ABOUT MY STUDENT'S ACCOUNT?

Detailed student account information can be found at LinqConnect.com. This was formerly the Titan Family Portal and houses balance information and spending reports.

WHAT IF I HAD A NEGATIVE ACCOUNT BALANCE AT THE END OF LAST YEAR?

Student meals without charge will begin on August 8, 2023. Any account activity prior to that date will remain unchanged. Please contact your school cafeteria for personal account information.
